Many of you may be regular visitors to London and have your favourite hot spots, however, if you are not familiar with the city, or are looking for some inspiration, we have provided some ideas below to help you make the most of your weekend:

Visitors from around the world flock to Knightsbridge and Brompton Road which offer shopping opportunities for prestigious brands as well as high street trends. Knightsbridge is also home to famous department stores Harvey Nichols and Harrods.

If you need to refuel from all of your shopping, there is a vast range of eateries in the area from Harvey Nichols' Fifth Floor Restaurant for afternoon tea to Dinner by Heston Blumenthal, a fine dining option for a special meal, with many more options in between.

You can escape the hustle and bustle of the City in Hyde Park, parallel to Knightsbridge. Hyde Park is one of eight Royal Parks in London and covers 350 acres. A number of famous landmarks sit in the park including: the Serpentine Lake, Speakers' Corner and the Diana, Princess of Wales, Memorial Fountain.

Along with cafes and restaurants, there is plenty to do and see such as: boating on the Serpentine, hiring a bike to cycle around the park or you could hire a deck chair and watch the world go by. You may also witness preparations for BBC's Proms in the Park, which is

taking place on Saturday 9 September.

Some of the biggest shows available throughout the weekend are: 42<sup>nd</sup> Street, showing on the West End's biggest stage on Drury Lane, Annie in Piccadilly Circus Theatre, the show where Miranda Hart has made her West End debut, Disney's Aladdin has been brought to

theatrical life at the Prince Edward Theatre, as well as the Lion King at the Lyceum Theatre, and Dreamgirls is currently showing at the Savoy Theatre having received critical and audience acclaim.
